

ACCREDITATION POLICY

CO'Met Orléans Open 2024

from 22/09 to 29/09



..... hereby acknowledge and agree to abide by the terms of the present accreditation policy in consideration of the issuance of my accreditation.

I. SCOPE

The present accreditation policy shall be binding on any individual who has been issued a temporary or permanent accreditation (hereinafter the "Accredited Person") by CO'Met Orléans Open - Internationaux de Tennis ATP (hereinafter the « CO'Met Orléans Open ») in relation to the 2024 tournament (hereinafter the "Tournament"). Signing the present accreditation policy shall constitute full acceptance by the Accredited Person of the terms and conditions hereof.

II. TERM OF VALIDITY

The present accreditation policy shall come into effect and be binding from the time of issuance to the Accredited Person of its tournament accreditation till:

- for temporary accreditations: the end of the day or the expiration of the term set out on the accreditation
- for permanent accreditations: the end of the Tournament

III. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

III. TERMS AND CONDITIONS Any Accredited Person acknowledges and agrees to fully abide by and comply with the following obligations:

1 Inalienability | Accreditations are non-transferable and must be visibly worn at all times while inside the stadium. | Offered tickets (with a face value of 0 €) can not be sold.

2 Taking of pictures-Video content | Unless approved in advance in writing by CO'Met Orléans Open - Internationaux de Tennis ATP, it is strictly forbidden to broadcast and/or to offer to the public, either live or delayed, in whole or in part, whether on a free basis or subject to payment, any sound recording and/or motion pictures captured by any means whatsoever inside the Stadium (especially on the competition court and inside any restricted areas including locker rooms and areas reserved for players) for any type of public access, and this regardless the means of transmission (Internet, radio, television, mobile phones, data storage accessories or any other current or future media). This prohibition includes, but is not limited to, any broadcasting and/or provision and/or incorporation of motion pictures and/or sound recordings captured inside the Stadium (especially on the competition court and inside any restricted areas including locker rooms and areas reserved for players) on any User Generated Content (UGC) website or platform, in any digital media as well as in any audiovisual output or work. In any event, any sound recording and/or motion picture collected or created by the Accredited Person during or in connection with Tournament matches or Tournament training sessions, shall remain the exclusive property of CO'Met Orléans Open - Internationaux de Tennis ATP, what Accredited Person hereby acknowledges and expressly agrees.

3 Gambling-Betting | Due to ethical issues with respect to protecting the integrity of tennis competitions, the Accredited Person shall not engage in or carry out, whether directly or through an intermediary, regardless the method (including by way of using on-line communication techniques), any form of gambling or betting activity whatsoever (including private gambling or betting between physical persons), in connection with the Tournament and/or people involved in the Tournament within the stadium. | Nor shall the Accredited Person communicate to any third party any privileged information acquired within the scope of her/his employment and unknown to the public, in connection with the Tournament and/or people involved in the Tournament.

4 Match related data and information | CO'Met Orléans Open - Internationaux de Tennis ATP is the sole and exclusive owner and organizer of the Tournament. Pursuant to the provisions of Article L333-1 of the French Code du Sport ; CO'Met Orléans Open - Internationaux de Tennis ATP owns all commercial rights in connection and relation thereto, including all data information and content produced during or arising out of any match of the Tournament in progress. | Accordingly, any Accredited Person attending a match of the Tournament or present inside the stadium is strictly forbidden from collecting, storing, disseminating, transmitting, disclosing, releasing and/or making available to any person or body whatsoever, by any means or technique.

whatsoever, whether on a free basis or subject to payment, any data, statistics, information or occurrence which she/he has knowledge (including but not limited to point by point live scoring, match, game and set statistics, warning given to a player, refereeing errors, call to the doctor, injury, player forfeit, etc.), in connection with any match of the Tournament in progress. | The continual use of laptop computers or other handheld electronic devices within the confines (spectator area) of the Tournament match court is prohibited. The exception to this provision is properly credentialed media, Tournament vendors and Tournament staff when used in the performance of their duties.

5 Non-compliance | In case of any breach by the Accredited Person of any of the obligations set out herein and/or of the Stadium Ground Regulations, CO'Met Orléans Open - Internationaux de Tennis ATP shall have the right to take all appropriate actions, including but not limited to, expulsion of the Accredited Person from the Stadium, temporary or permanent revocation of her/his accreditation, and termination of any and all associated rights.

6 Image clearance and authorization | To the extent permitted by law, Accredited Person grants without compensation to CO'Met Orléans Open - Internationaux de Tennis ATP and to the official broadcasters of the Tournament the right to use, exhibit and reproduce, worldwide, at their discretion, Accredited Person's likeness or image, or any visual description of the Accredited Person, made during the Tournament, for (i) promotion and publicity of the Tournament, (ii) information and news in relation to the Tournament, (iii) audio-visual coverage and broadcast of the Tournament, and (iv) archival exploitation purposes. | Accredited Person understands and agrees that such use of her/his image or likeness by CO'Met Orléans Open - Internationaux de Tennis ATP and the official broadcasters of the Tournament may be effected by way of any of the following technologies, distribution techniques and media: terrestrial and over the air, cable & satellite, VOD, mobile/cellular telephones and technology (DVB-H, 3G, 4G, UMTS, etc.), ADSL, DVD, VHS, UMD, Internet, on-demand services, narrow or broadband services, all other forms of online distribution now known or hereafter developed.

6 Personal data | Personal data provided by the Accredited Person will be processed electronically. These data, as well as the data processing, are necessary to issue and administrate the accreditations. CO'Met Orléans Open - Internationaux de Tennis ATP is the sole recipient of personal data collected. Personal data collected are reserved for the strict usage of issuing and administrating the accreditations and will not be passed on to any third party. Similarly, these data will in no circumstances be used for commercial purposes. | According to Article 39 and Article 40 of the French data protection act (French: loi du 6 janvier 1968 modifiée en 2004 relative à l'informatique, aux fichiers et aux libertés), the Accredited Person has the right to access and require modification, correction and deletion of her/his personal data. Such rights may be enforced by sending an e-mail to the DATA PROTECTION OFFICER OF CO'Met Orléans Open - Internationaux de Tennis ATP. | The Accredited Person may also, for legitimate reasons, oppose the processing of her/his personnel data. The Accredited Person can find information on her/his rights and obligations, and on the protection of personal data, on the French Data Protection Authority (French: Commission Nationale de l'Informatique et des Libertés) website: www.cnil.fr.

8 Applicable law/Jurisdiction | This accreditation policy shall be subject to French Law. The courts shall have exclusive jurisdiction in relation to any conflict whatsoever arising out of the accreditation policy, in connection with its interpretation and/or its execution.

9 Hierarchy of documents | This accreditation policy has been drawn up in French [La Charte des Accréditations] and translated in good faith into English.
